Advanced Notice

Our business will **resume operations as of 10:00 AM EDT, Tuesday, May 26th, 2020** per the [announcement made by the Office of the Governor](#) as part of the Phase 1 Healthy at Work initiative. Our organization will utilize the [ten rules to reopening a business under the Healthy at Work plan](#) and follow additional guidance provided by [the Kentucky Board of Cosmetology](#) and [Kentucky Healthy at Work Requirements](#). It is acknowledged that all services within the Professional Beauty Industry carry some risk in this viral environment due to the nature of the services provided and the inability to maintain social distancing. There is some associated risk in all human touch service environments, however, all licensed professionals in the Cosmetology industry have been trained to a national standard to mitigate these risks significantly through the use of proper infection control standards required by our governing regulatory licensing statutes and regulations.

How This Impacts Your Service

Clients will see the following changes as part of their service due to these new protocols:

- Clients must check via phone
 - Hair and Nail Services are by appointment only; schedule via phone/text/email only
- Customers will be screened by staff with the following questions:
 - Have you experienced any CDC-recognized COVID-19 symptoms (i.e. fever, cough, trouble breathing, etc.) in the past fourteen (14) days?
 - Are you living with or have you been exposed to anyone who is sick or quarantined?
 - You will be denied service and there will be a fourteen (14) day waiting period for any customers answering “Yes” to any of these questions.
- No more than 33% of our facility customer occupational capacity will be permitted at one time
- Waiting areas are closed and no guests are permitted
 - Clients are asked to maintain social distancing guidelines while waiting outside
 - Clients will receive a notification from the waitlist system or staff when it is your turn for service
- Clients will be required to wear face coverings before entering the facilities and for the duration of their service, as applicable; failure to do so will result in refusal of service
- Clients will be provided hand sanitizer for use before the start of their service
- Follow proper handwashing procedures as recommended by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention should your service require this
